SCHOOL CARD HOLDERS

These fees are for families approved under the School Card Scheme. Without notification of eligibility, families will be charged full fees unless other arrangements have been made.

DISCOUNTS

Early Payment Discount

Families choosing to pay all fees in total by 17 March will receive a 3% discount off the total fees.

Sibling Discount

The following discount is given to families with more than one student at Caritas College:

- second child 20% off annual tuition fee
- third child 75% off annual tuition fee
- fourth & subsequent children 100% off annual tuition fee

PAYMENT OPTIONS

The options available to pay for your child(children's) College fees:

- 1. Lump sum payment(s); paying the year's fees in full by 17 March each year via BPAY, Electronic Funds Transfer, EFTPOS or cash
- 2. Regular payment plan via PaySmart; paying the year's fees in full by the end of the school year
 Instalments are made by direct debit from your bank account or a credit card (surcharge applies for credit card transactions)
 - Instalments can be weekly, fortnightly, monthly, or quarterly between January and December

Families who encounter financial hardship will need to complete a fee variation form and request an appointment with the Principal or Business Manager. All applications are confidential and will be assessed on an individual basis.

IF WE ARE A SPLIT FAMILY, CAN WE RECEIVE SEPARATE STATEMENTS?

Yes, we can add a second address to our billing system, once an Enrolment Agreement is completed both parties will receive a copy of the same statement.

VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (VET) FEES

VET fees range from \$300 to over \$3,000 depending on the type of Certificate chosen. As VET is an elective pathway, the College will cover up to \$500 (course fees only) per student. The remaining VET fees will be charged to families. Please remember that College fees are still payable if a VET pathway is chosen, VET fees are an extra cost.

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE FEES?

Camps, Retreats and Excursions

These activities are all inclusive within the fee and are not refundable if you choose not to attend.

Stationery

The fee structure has been extended to include the supply of stationery items for all students. Families are not required to order or purchase stationery items. Stationery items will be supplied and distributed to students on the first day of school.

Student ID Cards

A Student ID Card is included in the school fees for Year 7-12 students however, there is a cost of \$5.00 for a replacement card if needed.

Textbooks

Textbooks are available for borrowing through the Library. Unreturned and damaged books will be charged to family accounts.

Laptops & Carry Bags

Year 7-12 students are issued a laptop. Each student completes a user agreement, outlining the use and care expectations, before receiving the laptop, no additional fee is charged for the laptop unless damaged or stolen. The laptop remains the property of Caritas College. It must be stored in the case provided, at all times, and returned to the College on completion of your child's education with us.

School Care Insurance

The College provides a school activities and excursions cover. This cover is designed so that anytime students are on school related activities the policy will provide 24-hour cover for Students' Personal Accident and Disability policy through Marsh Insurance.
