Dear Families

Your young person has been selected to participate in the **Year 11/12 boys and girls SSSSA Basketball competition** on Tuesday 24 September at **the Whyalla Basketball Stadium (Pat Kemp Stadium)**.

Students need to arrive at school at 7:45am (Woodforde St) and depart via bus to Whyalla for their respective competitions by 8:00am. The carnival will be played at Whyalla Basketball Stadium (Pat Kemp Stadium). Students will return via bus at approximately 3:15pm where they can be collected from school, walk home or drive (students with existing permission to drive).

What to bring / wear:

- A large drink bottle and normal packed school lunch
- Students to wear their PE uniform. Students will be given a college basketball singlet to wear at the game and will need to change back into their PE polo at the end of the day. **All singlets must be returned prior to leaving**
- Any strapping that your child needs must be organised before the event
- Jewellery to be removed
- If your young person has basketball shoes and/or a mouthguard they are encouraged to wear them

Parents are most welcome as spectators. In the best interest of child safety and privacy, we ask that parents do not take photographs of other students during this event. If this event is cancelled, a text message will be sent to the families.

As per the College's updated mobile device policy, all personal devices must be turned off and kept in bags for the duration of the excursion or handed in to staff at the start of the day, smart watches must be switched to flight mode. Students will not be permitted to use these at any point during the day until return to school. If you need to make contact with anyone, do so by contacting the front office and they will communicate with staff.

Participation in this event is conditional to students being up to date on all formative and summative tasks and meeting school expectations around responsibility, respect and safety. Communication will be made home if these expectations are not met.
