What to wear: Students will be required to provide their own white/light coloured top. Students to wear their PE uniform and will change into their top at school (7-9) with R-6 students coming to school ready. This top is recommended to be plain white for the colour to take full effect, it must have sleeves in line with the UV policy and students will be required to wear a hat. As the students make their way around the activity course there will be water slides and spray stations to maximise the impact of the colour, please keep this in mind when purchasing / organising a shirt. Optional: BYO sunglasses.

**Safety information**: The colour powder is non-toxic, non-flammable, environmentally friendly, biodegradable, skin safe and scent free. It is made of natural ingredients and permitted colours and is easy to clean from your clothes and surfaces. Students with lung issues such as asthma are advised to carefully consider participation, masks are encouraged.
