Dear Families

To support students as they begin to make decisions regarding post school pathways and related subject selections for their senior years of schooling, all Year 10 students are invited to attend a Post School Pathways Excursion to Adelaide. The purpose of the excursion is to provide an opportunity to experience a wider range of options, through visits to both tertiary and vocational education campuses, as well as job and business sites.

In preparation for the excursion, Pastoral Care lessons during Term 1 include topics such as:

*Learning about their personality types

*Compatible career pathways

*Setting goals and strategies to achieve

The planned itinerary for our excursion has some choices built in and during the PC lessons students have been given more information about each visit, then selected venues that best suit their possible career pathway. For those who are considering a VET pathway in 2026 we require that they choose the Group A activities for at least one day. The itinerary, with your young person's choices highlighted is attached to this letter. If, after a conversation at home, students wish to make any changes they must let me know by **Wednesday 19 March** so final bookings can be confirmed.

All medication, other than asthma puffers, is to be clearly labelled with clear directions, bagged and given to staff
on Wednesday morning.

As per mobile phone policy, mobile phones and personal devices must be turned off when on school camps/excursions unless the teacher advises students that a device may be used for a specific purpose.

All excursion costs will be covered by the school; however, students may bring a small amount of spending money for additional snacks if required.
